Gala Honorees

Murray Brenman & Beth Ando-Brenman

Murray and Beth moved to East Windsor in 1982 and found their home at Beth El Synagogue in 1998. Their sons, Ari and Zach were both tutored by Leslie Kornsgold for their B'nai Mitzvah at Beth El, attended Hebrew High School and were active in USY.

Over the years, Beth has run programs for Women's League and Mitzvah Day. You may have seen her gardening on Beth El grounds. Beth's "heart and soul" connection to the Beth El community was chairing and expanding its Bikkur Cholim Society for over 12 years. She currently enjoys being active with Bikkur Cholim and the Rosh Chodesh Group.

Murray designed and produced the Shalom for 5 years, refined the Beth El logo design, and produced various brochures, flyers, ad journals and promotional materials. He also co-coordinated the Beth El L'Chaim Bike Rides. He is a Ritual Committee member, serving as chair for 13 years, Men's Club member, and he continues to read Torah and lead daily and Shiva Minyanim from time to time.

Beth worked in the Graphic Design field before becoming a Physical Therapist for 22 years, including running a Dizziness and Balance Clinic. Since 2019, she has been a Community Health Educator at CentraState Hospital, teaching topics in Wellness, Balance, Yoga, Tai Chi and CPR.



Murray spent 8 years as a record company Art Director, ran his own Graphic Design studio for over 25 years, and has been a Garden Apartment Property Manager for the last 14 years.

Both Beth and Murray retired in 2025 and enjoy hiking, bike riding (especially participating in JFCS Wheels For Meals rides), traveling and spending time with Ari, daughter-in-love Hannah, granddaughters Rachel, Tamar and Miriam, and of course with Zach.
