3. Parents are expected to maintain the decorum of their children during services. Babysitting will be provided for preschool children (2-5 years old) on Rosh Hashanah mornings, Kol Nidre evening and Yom Kippur until 3:30 p.m.
4. Male congregants are required to wear a kippah (yarmulke) in the synagogue and a tallit when appropriate.
5. Women are requested to wear a head covering when honored at the bimah, and are encouraged to wear a tallit when honoring the Torah (for Aliyot) or at any other time during the service.
6. Entering and exiting services will be at the ushers' discretion when the Ark is open, the Torah is being read, during sermons and standing prayers.
7. Please enhance the sanctity of the recitation of Hinei and refrain from moving around the Sanctuary while the Cantor proceeds up the Sanctuary aisle.
8. Food is not permitted in the Sanctuary.
9. Tickets are not transferable.
