Before the reading of the Law:

בָרוּדְ אָתִריִיָ הַמְבֹרָדְ הַשְׁבֹרָדְ Barchu et Ado-nai ha-m'vorach. בְּרוּדְ יְיָ הַמְבֹרָדְ לְעוֹכָם וָעֶד. Baruch Ado-nai ha-m'vorach l'olam va-ed. בְּרוּדְ אַתָּה יְיָ, אָאָלהֵינוּ מֶכָּל־ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁער בָּחַר־בְּנו מִכָּל־ הָעַמִּים, וְנָתַן־לָנוּ אֶת־תּוֹרָתוֹ, בָּרוּדְ אַתָּה יְיָ, נוֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה.

Baruch ata Ado-nai, Elo-heinu Melech ha'olam, asher bachar banu mi-kol ha-amim, v'natan lanu et Torato, Baruch ata Ado-nai, notain ha-torah.

After the reading of the Law:

בָּרִוּדָ אַתָּה יְיָ, אָאָלהֵינוּ מֶלֶד הֶעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר נְתַזְ־לָנוּ תּוֹרַת אֶמֶת וְחַיֵּי עוֹלָם נְטַע בְּתוֹכֵנוּ. בְּרוּדָ אַתָּה יְיָ, נוֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה.

Baruch ata Ado-nai, Elo-heinu Melech ha'olam, asher natan lonu torat emet v'cha-yei olam nota b'to-chei-nu. Baruch ata Ado-nai, notain ha-torah.

How the blessings are recited:

- You kiss the Torah where the reader points (using your tzitzit or a siddur or a cloth, but without touching the torah scroll with your hand), hold onto the wooden Torah handle, and begin: *Bar'chu et Ado-nai Ham'vorach*
- Congregation responds: *Baruch Ado-nai Ham'vorach* L'olam *Va'ed*
- You <u>repeat</u> their response: *Baruch Ado-nai Ham'vorach L'olam Va'ed*
- You then continue: Baruch Atah Ado-nai, Eloheynu Melech Haolam, Asher Bachar Banu Mikol Ha-amim, V'natan Lanu et Torato, Baruch Atah Ado-nai, Noten Ha-Torah.
- Congreagation responds: Amen.
- Torah *is* read.
- Kiss the *Torah* again, and recite the concluding blessing: *Baruch Atah Ado-nai, Eloheynu Melech Ha-olam, Asher Natan Lanu Torat Emet, V'chayei Olam Nata B'tocheinu, Baruch Atah Ado-nai, Noten Ha-Torah.*
- Congregation responds: Amen
- Remember to stay up on the bima until the next Aliyah is complete. Then you may return to your seat.
- Afterwards congregants may wish you "*yishar koach*," (meaning "well done," literally "have strength,") and you may respond "baruch *tihyeh*," meaning "be blessed."
- You've just had an Aliyah. *Yishar Koach*! May you have many more honors and go from strength to strength.
